From Monday 9th November we will be operating under different regulations issued by the Welsh Government. This means there are some new rules for booking with us and we will need a few more details from you when you book and when you arrive. Please remember that this is new to us as well and will take a while for us all to get used to these new rules but we will do our very best to make it as simple as we can for everyone.

The maximum number of people that can meet is now set to four (not including children under 11) indoors and outdoors. These can be from different households and the only exception is if four or more people live together in one household.

You can book a table for a maximum of 2 ¼ hours. It is now mandatory for all customers to give verified contact details for NHS Wales Test, Trace Protect Services.

When booking a table we will need to take the names and contact numbers of all the people for that booking. When you arrive, we will ask you all to verify your information - bank cards, credit cards or driving licences are adequate.

If you are booking a table of more than four people that live in a single household all adults will be required to provide proof of name and address on your arrival (driving licence, or an electronic or paper based official document official document).

We will take all food and drink orders from your table. We encourage customers to order from our easy to use online ordering app where possible, to minimise contact between staff and customers.

Please wear face coverings except when eating and drinking (excludes children under 11).
